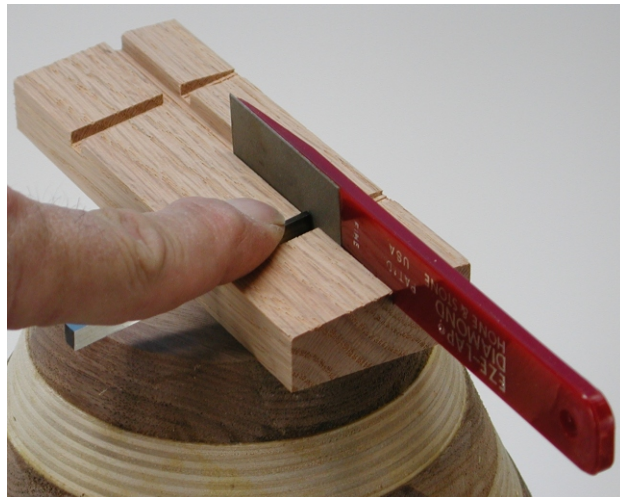
Shown above is the Diamond Hone and the sharpening jig along with a blade - note cutting edge of blade is 8 degrees.



Note: Blade is held so as the angle of the blade is parallel with the long slot cut into the jig. When the diamond hone is inserted in the slot, it is aligned with the blade.



Note - alignment of the edge of the blade with the slot in the sharpening jig.



Holding the blade snugly into the angle slot and aligning the front of the blade with the horizontal slot, simply insert the diamond hone into the horizontal slot and while pushing on the blade to maintain contact with the hone, run the hone past the blade surface several times, in a front to back motion to sharpen the blade.

Sharpening the Ring Master blades is a simple task. Do not over sharpen as excessive sharpening will not make the blade any sharper, just grind away more of the blade, thus reducing the overall life of the blades. Try taking a marker and blackening the end of the blade - and just sharpen till the blade is shiny along the entire cutting edge. That's all there is to it.
